Beautiful color for late season gardens and fall displays...

Aconitum 'Arendsii', No.1 – An unusual color for autumn and so vivid too with its rich violet-blue hooded flowers. The upright foliage to 3-4' tall and unique blooms will make its presence known in the fall garden. Attractive budded foliage fills the pots.

Brilliance Autumn Fern, No.1 – Fronds in hues of the autumn season fill the pots. What a great time to plant this beautiful fern!

Fortune's Hardy Holly Fern, No.1 – An attractive evergreen fern indoor or out, (to zone 5), that will offer many uses in the garden or in fall and winter arrangements. Stiff, upright dark green foliage fills the pots.

Heuchera 'Caramel', No.1 – This caramel apple colored Heuchera is perfect for fall displays and year round in the garden. Full and nice!

Heucherella 'Solar Eclipse', No.1 – Leaves are becoming infused with bronze-red bordered by a contrasting lime green margin...the overall effect is striking and sure to turn some heads!

Muhlenbergia capillaris, No.2 – Pinkish-red puffy panicles are blooming above the stiff and narrow upright foliage! An excellent choice for mass planting or as an accent.

Budded and/or Blooming

Aster 'October Skies'; Begonia grandis; Ceratostigma plumbaginoides; Chrysanthemum 'Pink Cloud'; Echinacea 'Kim's Knee High'(qts); Sisyrinchium 'Lucerne'.

Blue Star Creeper; Geranium 'Karmina'; Heuchera 'Blondie', 'Midnight Rose', 'Palace Purple' & 'Plum Pudding'; Heucherella 'Blue Ridge' & 'Sweet Tea'; Iris ensata 'Variegata'; Japanese Holly Fern; Korean Rock Fern; Liatris 'Foristan White' & 'Kobold'; Penstemon 'Husker Red'; Sedum 'Makino'; Tiarella 'Brandywine' & 'Timbuktu'.
